

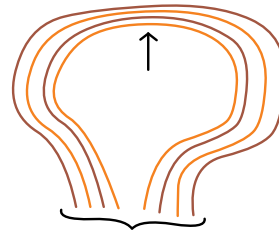


Bracelet Buckle

Start with looking in what order the coloured threads should be in the pattern you're going to make.
The threads should be a bit longer than when you make ordinary bracelets.

Start tying here!

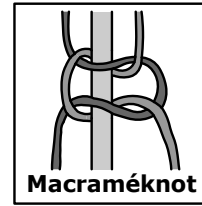
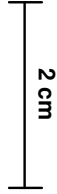
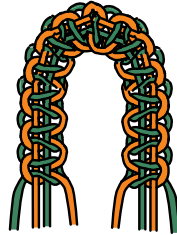


The threads shall be in this order when starting with the bracelet pattern.

Start in the middle and make some makramé knots.

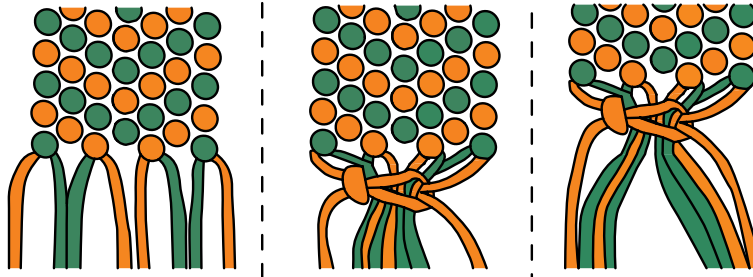


Now, bend the whole thing.

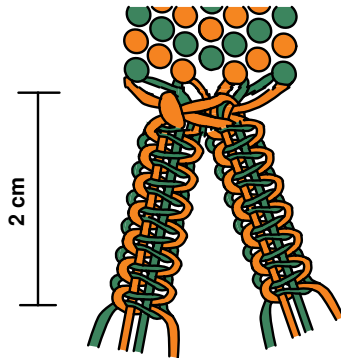


When you've done this, you can make the bracelet pattern.
The pattern should be about 4 cm less than your wrists circumference.

After the bracelet pattern, it's time to make the buckle:

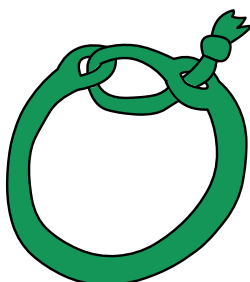
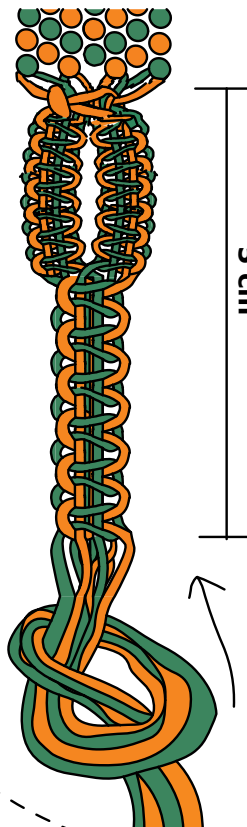


Make a makramé knot to gather all threads, then split then in two bunches.



Make two lines of makramé knots.

Make a line of makramé knots of all threads.
Finish the buckle with a knot as shown.



Finished!
This is how you "lock" the bracelet. The protruding knot keeps the bracelet locked.
